Aging in rural West Marin comes with unique challenges. The natural beauty and quiet of our coastal and inland towns can also mean long distances from grocery

to communities like Tomales, Nicasio, and the San Geronimo Valley, we truly go the distance to bring support and care to older adults throughout West Marin.


Within our service area, we offer a wide variety of services at no cost to support seniors aging at home & in community:

- Care Management One-on-one support to help seniors navigate medical care, housing, in-home help, and changing needs with dignity and guidance. Home-
- Delivered Meals Nutritious meals delivered right to the door, providing both sustenance and a friendly check-in from our dedicated volunteers. In 2024 we delivered 8700+ meals!
- Senior Lunch at the Dance Palace A monthly community gathering with a hot meal, live music, and warm conversation in a welcoming setting. Workshops &
- Classes Free online and in-person programs designed to empower and connect people on topics like advance care planning, fall prevention, healthy aging, and more...
- Transportation Coordination Help arranging rides to essential appointments or community events for those with mobility or transportation challenges.
- Resource Referrals Guidance in accessing local, county, and state programs that support aging in place safely and with peace of mind.

In addition to the services we provide, WMSS offers advocacy in the larger community.

On Tuesday, our Executive Director, Skip, spoke at a public forum put on by the Marin Commission on Aging about the biggest health challenges we face as we age. One key message from the day was clear: *most older adults want to stay in their homes and remain part of their community* whether they live in a city or a rural area. That's exactly the kind of care and connection WMSS provides to rural seniors. But the challenges are real.

In rural communities like ours, issues like transportation and housing are even more difficult, and senior programs need more support to meet these growing needs.




